#### **RESOLUTION NO. 7-2014**

### A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE OFFICIAL COUNTY NEWSPAPER.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, upon due consideration of the matter finds that enacting the legislation would provide an official newspaper for publications of Cherokee County, Kansas.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, meeting in regular session, this 24th day of February, 2014, does hereby resolve as follows:

**Section 1. Appointment of Official County Newspaper.** Pursuant to K.S.A. 64-101 the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, is required to appoint a duly qualifying newspaper as the official newspaper for publications of Cherokee County, Kansas. This Board hereby appoints the Cherokee County News-Advocate, the office of which is located in Baxter Springs, Kansas, as the official county newspaper pursuant to K.S.A. 64-101.

**Section 2. Severability.** If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this resolution, or the application thereof to any circumstances, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this resolution.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication once in the official county newspaper.
