Commissioner Frazier moved to pay Barbara Wright one week of her 2021 vacation. Commissioner Anderson 2nd, motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Anderson moved to sign a Cherokee County Proclamation. This Proclamation is dedicated to all citizens in Cherokee County in recognition of their many sacrifices, and determination to work together in the face of great adversity for the well-being of all citizens. Commissioner Moates 2nd, motion passed 3-0.
