MINUTES FOR MARCH 25, 2019

BOARD OF CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS

Chairman Cory Moates called the regular session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (The Board), to order at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 25, 2019 in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioner Neal Anderson opened the meeting with prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioners Cory Moates, Neal Anderson, Myra Carlisle Frazier, County Counselor Barbara Wright, and County Clerk Rodney Edmondson were present.

Members of the press present: Larry Hiatt

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates to approve the minutes from the March 18, 2019 BOCC regular meeting as corrected. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Frazier. The motion carried 3-0.

Debbie Hopkins representing the Baxter Springs Lions Club, appeared before the Board to update them on the Senior Prom Titled Day of Enchantment being held at the Spring River Wellness Center on April 25th.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates to donate \$300 from the General Fund Recreation Fund to the event. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0. \$100 will be deducted from each of the Commissioners' accounts.

Leonard Vanatta, County Road Supervisor and Louis Schreiner, County Lot Supervisor appeared before the Board on county road business. They discussed adding vehicles and property to the list of items for the Purple Wave Auction. They will have a list for Counselor Wright next Monday. The Board asked them to check on a hole in a bridge deck just west of 50th St. on NE Belleview Rd. Louis stated that it has had a steel plate over the hole and he'll check to see if that has been stolen. Leonard reported that the EPA project on SW 20th St. is finishing quicker than expected, so he'll need to get going on the bridge project in that area. Commissioner Frazier informed them that Vision Link is reporting that a grader is being operated with the parking brake on while in motion. Louis will check on it.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates for an executive session for the discipline of nonelected personnel with the Board, Leonard Vanatta, and Louis Schreiner. The meeting will reconvene in the commission room at 9:57 a.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0 at 9:47 a.m.

The meeting reconvened at 9:57 a.m.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates to accept the resignation of brush cutter Tim Hatfield effective March 29th. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Frazier. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson to approve the payroll for the period ending March 15, 2019. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Moates. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates to approve the accounts payable for the period ending March 21, 2019. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0.

Doug Mogle representing Ambulance District No. 1 and No. 2, appeared before the Board. He provided an overview of the 501(c)(3) structure for those districts. He reported that there is a 20 member board that is elected every year. He gave a staffing report and provided a complete written financial update and year end statement. He stated that he would like to sit down with members of the Board over lunch or coffee to talk about the future direction of the service. The Board thanked him for the job that he and his service has done for the citizens of Cherokee County.

Art Mallory presented three properties for the Board to consider under the abandoned structure resolution for possible condemnation. The three properties are located at SE 71St St. & Center Rd., SE 40th St., and SE Prairie Rd. Commissioner Frazier asked the Board to table the item until next week to allow her time to view the properties. The Board agreed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates for an attorney/client executive session for contract purposes with the Board, Counselor Wright, Clerk Edmondson, and Ralph Houser. The meeting will reconvene in the commission room at 10:33 a.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0 at 10:28 a.m.

The meeting reconvened at 10:33 a.m.

No action was taken during the executive session.

Thomas Niegisch of KissTECH appeared before the Board regarding the sound system in the commission room. He presented a microphone with stand and cable to the Board to consider for the public to use when appearing before the Board. The cost of the additional microphone feature is \$85.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson to accept the bid for the microphone, stand, and cable from KissTECH in the amount of \$85. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Frazier. The motion carried 3-0.

Clerk Edmondson presented the two estimates for new floor covering for the Court Services Offices for the Board to review. The Board placed the item on the agenda for next Monday to allow time for the insurance company to respond.

Counselor Wright presented a request from a citizen, Kevin Back, for the county to vacate platted roads that are not developed on his properties. He is making the request so he can combine four parcels into one. He owns all of the property and there are no adjoining land owners. Counselor Wright will contact him and ask him to provide the legal descriptions so a resolution can be drafted.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates for an attorney/client executive session for litigation purposes and for potential conflicts. The meeting will reconvene in the commission room at 11:15 a.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0 at 10:51 a.m.

The meeting reconvened at 11:15 a.m.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson to allow the Chair to sign the Answers to Interrogatories in the Brandon Johnson case. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Frazier. The motion carried 3-0.

Jason Allison appeared before the Board stating that he is waiting on the final bill from Federal Signals for the installation of the storm sirens. Once he has it he will submit it for the 75% reimbursement from the grant. He stated that they are starting a new project for the open septic's that have been reported on Gum Lane. He has spoken with the Sheriff regarding pit bull dogs in that area and he is going to assist.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates to recess until 12:30 p.m. for the budget workshop with Sheriff Groves for the Sheriff and Jail budgets. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0 at 11:27 a.m.

The meeting reconvened at 12:30 p.m. for the budget workshop with Sheriff Groves for the Sheriff and Jail budgets.

No action was taken during the workshop.

Commissioner Frazier made a motion to adjourn until the next regular meeting set for Monday, April 1, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0 at 1:40 p.m.
