Road & Bridge Supervisor, Leonard Vanatta and Assistant Supervisor, Cody Zook reported that the FEMA project on Cherry Creek in the NW part of the County had been completed. They also reported that the rental Track hoe was ready to be returned and that they were ready to start some additional projects.

Cord Mayes, Cherokee County Noxious Weed Department Supervisor, reported on some strategies for fall 2020, and spring 2021 applications.

Commissioner Moates move to extend the bid for the lap- top for Cord Mayes from \$1500 to \$1682.08 Commissioner Anderson 2nd, motion passed 3-0.

Discussion was held on the Riverton sewer district rates.

Commissioner Anderson moved to approve a one- time payment to be paid from payroll for Administrative fees for three administrators of the SPARKS program as recommended. Commissioner Moates 2nd, motion passed. 3-0.

Cherokee County resident Brad Biddle came before THE COMMISSION with a concern about County Employees out of the Appraisers department on private property.

Commissioner Anderson moved to renew contracts with four independent attorneys for the calendar year 2021. Commissioner Frazier 2nd, motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Frazier moved to adjourn until the next regular session November 16, 2020. Commissioner Anderson 2nd, motion passed. 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 11:12 a.m.
