MINUTES FOR NOVEMBER 17, 2014

BOARD OF CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS

CONVENE

Commissioner Hilderbrand called the regular session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (The Board), to order and led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance at 9:00 AM on Monday, November 17, 2014 in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioners Richard Hilderbrand, Charles Napier, Pat Collins, and County Clerk Rodney Edmondson were present.

Members of the press present: Larry Hiatt, Machelle Smith, Jordan Zabel

A motion was made by Commissioner Napier to approve the Minutes of the November 10, 2014 BOCC Meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hilderbrand. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Napier to approve the Payroll for the month of November, 2014. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Napier to approve the Accounts Payables for the month of November, 2014. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0.

Brent Hillier and Brian Hillier - Benefit Health Advisors

They appeared before the Board along with employee members of the Health Insurance Committee. They provided an update on the current health plan as well as information regarding the plan renewal set for January 1, 2015. The committee recommends going with ARCH as the reinsurance carrier, unless the current carrier ARBOR will match the bid. They also recommend staying with Meritain as the plan administrator.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to adopt the recommended plan changes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

At 10:00 AM the Board recessed to the District Courtroom for the KAC Awards Ceremony to recognize county employees for their years of service.

The meeting reconvened at 10:30 AM in the Commission Room.

Property Tax Relief Applications - Baxter Springs Tornado

The Board reviewed Property Tax Relief Applications for consideration of tax abatements to homesteads damaged as a result of the tornado in Baxter Springs on April 27, 2014.

The Board reviewed the following applications and made determinations as indicated.

Terri Tessman - 1913 Park Ave, 1915 Park Ave, and 1918 Lincoln Ave. All homes were destroyed and were removed by Moates Excavating. A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand, seconded by Commissioner Napier to grant a 100% abatement. The motion carried 3-0.

All properties are located within the city limits of Baxter Springs. The abatements granted are for tax year 2014. The approved abatements will apply to property taxes on structures. Land values and taxes assessed on land are not affected.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to amend the agenda from 11:45 AM to 11:02 AM for Sandra Friend of the Shawnee Township. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 at 11:02 AM.

Sandra Friend - Shawnee Township

She appeared before the Board on behalf of the Shawnee Township Board. They are seeking the county's authority to negotiate a long term lease for a building in Crestline to be used by the township as a community center. The township would be responsible for the maintenance of the building. They will also contact other townships to see if they are interested in using it also. The Board will consult with Counselor Nathan Coleman regarding obligations to the county in a long term lease. The township is also wanting to get their cemetery information online. They would like to purchase a computer program to map out the information.

The Board will contact her after review by Mr. Coleman.

Kim Lauffer - County Appraiser

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to enter an Executive Session with the Board, County Appraiser Kim Lauffer, and County Clerk Rod Edmondson for the purpose of Non/Elected Personnel for a period of 10 minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 at 11:17 AM.

The meeting reconvened at 11:27 AM.

County Appraiser Kim Lauffer announced that she was tendering her resignation effective on July 1, 2015.

The Board signed a contract with Mark Hixon, current Shawnee County Appraiser, to become Assistant Appraiser on March 1, 2015 and to replace Lauffer as Appraiser on July 1, 2015.

Nathan Coleman - County Counselor

He appeared before the Board regarding legal matters concerning Cherokee County.

Attorney Larry Prauser appeared before the Board to schedule a fence viewing as requested by his client. The viewing was scheduled for December 8, 2014 at 2:00 PM at a location three miles north and 1.5 miles east of the Columbus Ford intersection.

Juanita Hodgson, County Treasurer, appeared with Mr. Coleman to inform them of recent developments with USD 247 regarding taxes that were collected in 2013 that were levied incorrectly. USD 247 has refunded the money to Crawford, Cherokee, Labette, and Neosho Counties. Mr. Coleman has spoken with Crawford County Counselor and is in agreement that the county should send the money back to USD 247. The county cannot hold the money, and USD 247 needs to work on a resolution. It affects 2,162 tax statements from Cherokee County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to enter an Executive Session with the Board, County Counselor Nathan Coleman, Sheriff David Groves, and Under-Sheriff Terry Clugston for the purpose of Non/Elected Personnel for a period of 10 minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 at 11:47 AM.

The meeting reconvened at 11:57 AM.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to enter an Executive Session with the Board, County Counselor Nathan Coleman, Sheriff David Groves, and Under-Sheriff Terry Clugston for the purpose of Non-/Elected Personnel for a period of 10 minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 at 11:57 AM.

The meeting reconvened at 12:07 PM.

No action was taken as a result of the Executive Session.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to recess for lunch until 1:15 PM. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 at 12:12 PM.

Steve Goehl - D.A. Davidson & Co.

He appeared before the Board to bring an update on the potential refinancing of the Series 2005 Certificates of Participation on the financing of the Law Enforcement Center. He stated that the county is in the area needed to refinance. Current markets would yield a present value saving of \$575,000 and would be paid in full in 2020 instead of 2021 as is currently scheduled. If refinancing is done, it would be a tax exempt bond because advance refunding has already been done once before. The interest rate would be approximately 2.19%. If desired the Board would need a motion to move forward with a base, such as 2.5%. The Board will take time to consider all options. Mr. Goehl will forward a copy of the proposal to Gene Mense.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to enter an Executive Session with the Board for the purpose of Non/Elected Personnel for a period of 10 minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 at 1:32 PM.

The meeting reconvened at 1:42 PM.

No action was taken as a result of the Executive Session.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to adjourn until the next regularly scheduled meeting set for November 24, 2014 at 9:00 AM. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes at 1:43 PM.
