A RESOLUTION ASSURING THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE THAT FUNDS WILL BE CONTINUALLY PROVIDED FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE <u>BRIDGE</u> SYSTEM TO BE FINANCED WITH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, The City/County of <u>Cherokee</u> is applying for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds under the Community Improvement Category, as administered by the Kansas Department of Commerce; and,

WHEREAS, The City/County of <u>Cherokee</u> wishes to utilize this funding for the purpose of constructing improvements to the city's/county's <u>Bridge</u> system, as described in the Community Development Block Grant application submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce; and,

WHEREAS, The City/County of <u>Cherokee</u> has determined that the annual operation and maintenance costs of the <u>Bridge</u> system improvements are anticipated to be approximately \$900; and,

WHEREAS, The annual <u>Road and Bridge</u> budget has been determined to be adequate to fund the operation and maintenance of the <u>Bridge</u> system,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Governing Body of the City/County of <u>Cherokee</u>, Kansas, hereby assures the Kansas Department of Commerce that sufficient funds will be provided for the continued operation and maintenance of the above described improvement; that these operation and maintenance costs will be reviewed annually; and that the budget will be adjusted, when necessary, to reflect and cover any increase in costs.
