RESOLUTION NO. 10 - 2015 A RESOLUTION REGARDING CERTAIN COUNTY ROAD SIGNAGE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS:

WHEREAS, the County in the form of its duly elected governing body has the authority under K.S.A. § 19-101 to determine its local affairs and government, and;

WHEREAS, the County in the form of its duly elected governing body has the authority under K.S.A. § 19-212 to exercise control over and to perform such duties respecting county roads as may be provided by law; and;

WHEREAS, the County Engineer, after inspection of that certain intersection of county road NW 125th and Scammon road, has recommended to the Board that traffic control signage be added to said intersection in order that traffic from all four directions be required to stop before proceeding through the intersection (four-way stop).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, meeting in regular session, this 20th day of July, 2015, does hereby resolve as follows:

- 1. That the intersection of county road NW 125th and Scammon road shall display traffic control signage requiring traffic from all four directions to stop before proceeding through the intersection.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication once in the official county newspaper.
