MINUTES FOR AUGUST 6, 2018

BOARD OF CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS

CONVENE

Chairman Cory Moates called the regular session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (The Board), to order at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, August 6, 2018 in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioner Neal Anderson opened the meeting with prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioners Cory Moates, Pat Collins, Neal Anderson, County Counselor Barbara Wright, and County Clerk Rodney Edmondson were present.

Members of the press present: Larry Hiatt

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the minutes of the July 30, 2018 BOCC meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0.

Leonard Vanatta, County Road Supervisor, appeared before the Board on county road business. He reported that the asphalting on Sportsman Pit Rd. should be finished tomorrow. He reported that for the bridge project near Faulkner there will be one electric pole to be moved at the expense of the county. There will be no charge for the other pole that is in the county right-of-way.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates to close all county offices on Christmas Eve, Monday, December 24th, 2018. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0.

Counselor Barbara Wright presented three resolutions for a first read for the condemnation of three buildings as authorized by the Board last week. The Board placed the resolutions on the agenda for next week.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins for an attorney client executive session for contract purposes with the Board, Counselor Wright, and Clerk Edmondson for a period of 10 minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0 at 9:53 a.m.

The meeting reconvened at 10:03 a.m.

A motion was made by Commissioner Moates for a five minute recess. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0 at 10:04 a.m.

The meeting reconvened at 10:09 a.m.

Department Heads - Monthly Reports

Officials met with the Board for their routine monthly meeting for the purpose of updating the Board on happenings within each department, with the following department heads present: Barbara Bilke, Register of Deeds; Betha Elliott, Health Department; David Groves, Sheriff; Deana Randall, Human Resources; Mark Hixon, Appraiser; Raven Elmore, Treasurer; Rodney Edmondson, Clerk & Election; and Wayne Elliott, 911 Addressing & Mapping.

David Groves reminded everyone that the Weir Homecoming is September 14th & 15th. He stated that the Farm Show is being moved to May instead of July for 2019. He presented a request to work with the County Lot to purchase some bicyclist and pedestrian awareness signs to be placed in areas where those persons are often present to raise the awareness of other motorists. The Board approved his request. He also stated that his office just received a box of papers for service to citizens from Mr. Myers for a tax sale. They are processing them as fast as possible.

Deana Randall stated that she will be going to a class August 22-24th and asked for everyone to turn in payroll and expenses by the deadline of August 20th.

Mark Hixon reported that 88 sales of property have been worked through June. He stated that property values are running at 3% under the sale price.

Raven Elmore provided a recap report of all county funds. She stated that the delinquent tax list has been delivered to the newspaper for publication.

Rod Edmondson reported that they are preparing for the primary election tomorrow.

Wayne Elliott reported the issuance of one new address, bringing the total number for the year to 22. They also issued one permit for a new house, and sold 13 maps for \$38.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins for an executive session for the discipline of non-elected personnel with the Board for a period of 15 minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0 at 10:33 a.m.

The meeting reconvened at 10:48 a.m.

No action was taken during the executive session.

Commissioner Collins made a motion to adjourn until the next regular meeting set for Monday, August 13, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 3-0 at 10:50 a.m.
